



## QUILTS OF HONOR 'EMBLEM' PILLOWCASE

These pillowcase instructions are for the different services' Emblem panels — Navy, Army, Marines, and Air Force.

### CUTTING

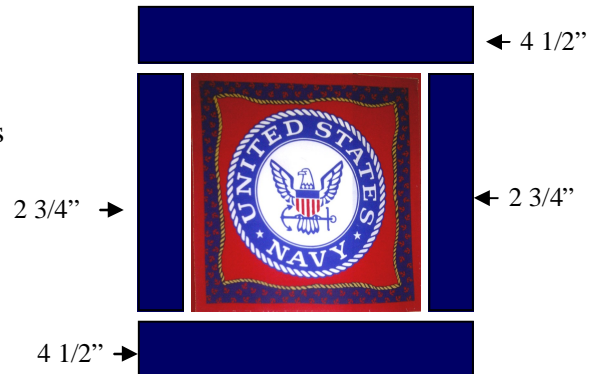
- Emblem: \*Trim Emblem to measure 17 1/2" wide by 17" long.  
 \*Cut side borders 2 3/4 inches wide by length of emblem  
 \*Cut top & bottom borders 4 1/2" wide by width of emblem & added side borders
- Back Panel: Cut fabric for back panel 22" wide by 25" long
- Cuff: 10 1/2 inches by width of fabric
- Trim: 3 inches by width of fabric—press in half lengthwise, wrong sides together.



Trim to 17 1/2" wide by 17 long leaving 3/4" of red border on all sides.

### ASSEMBLY

- \* Attach side borders to emblem, press towards borders
- \* Attach top and bottom borders to emblem, press towards borders
- \* Sew front and back panels together **WRONG** sides together using a 1/4" seam—press
- \* Turn right sides together and stitch again to enclose the raw edges of the first seam—use a 3/8" to 1/2" seam allowance to enclose the raw edges.
- \* Layer the three components as follows:



- a) Cuff fabric: **Right side up**
- b) Folded Trim: **Right side out** with raw edges even with cuff edges
- c) Body: **Right side down** along same edge

Pin together along edge but do not sew

- \* Roll the remaining body fabric up from the bottom (like a tube) until the remaining Cuff fabric is revealed. Bring end of Cuff fabric **OVER** the rolled up body, **wrong side up**, along the raw edges. Sew all layers together with strong 1/4" seam. When sewn, you will have a long tube. Pull the Body fabric out of the tube and press the seam well.
- \* Fold the pillowcase in half lengthwise, **WRONG** sides together. Trim off any excess fabric and selvages along the side making sure the cut edge is perpendicular to the cuff seam. Sew 1/4 inch along the side and bottom. Trim stray threads as necessary. Turn pillowcase inside out and press.
- \* Stitch the seam again using a 3/8" to 1/2" seam to enclose the raw edges of the first seam. Backstitch at the beginning and end of the seam.
- \* Turn and Press
